## **Section 2. Extending Existing Entities**

This section covers allowable scenarios for extending existing core entities in the Ed-Fi data model.

- 2.1. Extend Domain Entity
- 2.2. Extend Association Entity

## 2.1. Extend Domain Entity

An existing domain entity such as a Student can be extended to add new elements.\*

- MUST NOT contain any identity properties.
- MUST NOT contain entity-level documentation.
- MUST contain at least one property.
- MUST NOT contain properties included in the parent domain entity unless additional context is provided.
- MUST include any properties as optional single properties or optional collections.\*\*
- MUST NOT include required properties (as single properties or collections).
- \* There are some known exceptions for extending domain entities. See Unsupported Modifications for more details.
- \*\* An exception applies to collections of simple types. Only string and decimal simple types may be included as collections.

## 2.2. Extend Association Entity

An existing association entity such as the StudentParentAssociation entity can be extended to add new elements.\*\*\*

- MUST NOT contain any identity properties.
- MUST NOT contain entity-level documentation.
- MUST contain at least one property.
- MUST NOT contain properties included in the parent association unless additional context is provided.
- MUST include any properties as optional single properties or optional collections.\*\*\*\*
- MUST NOT include required properties (as single properties or collections).
